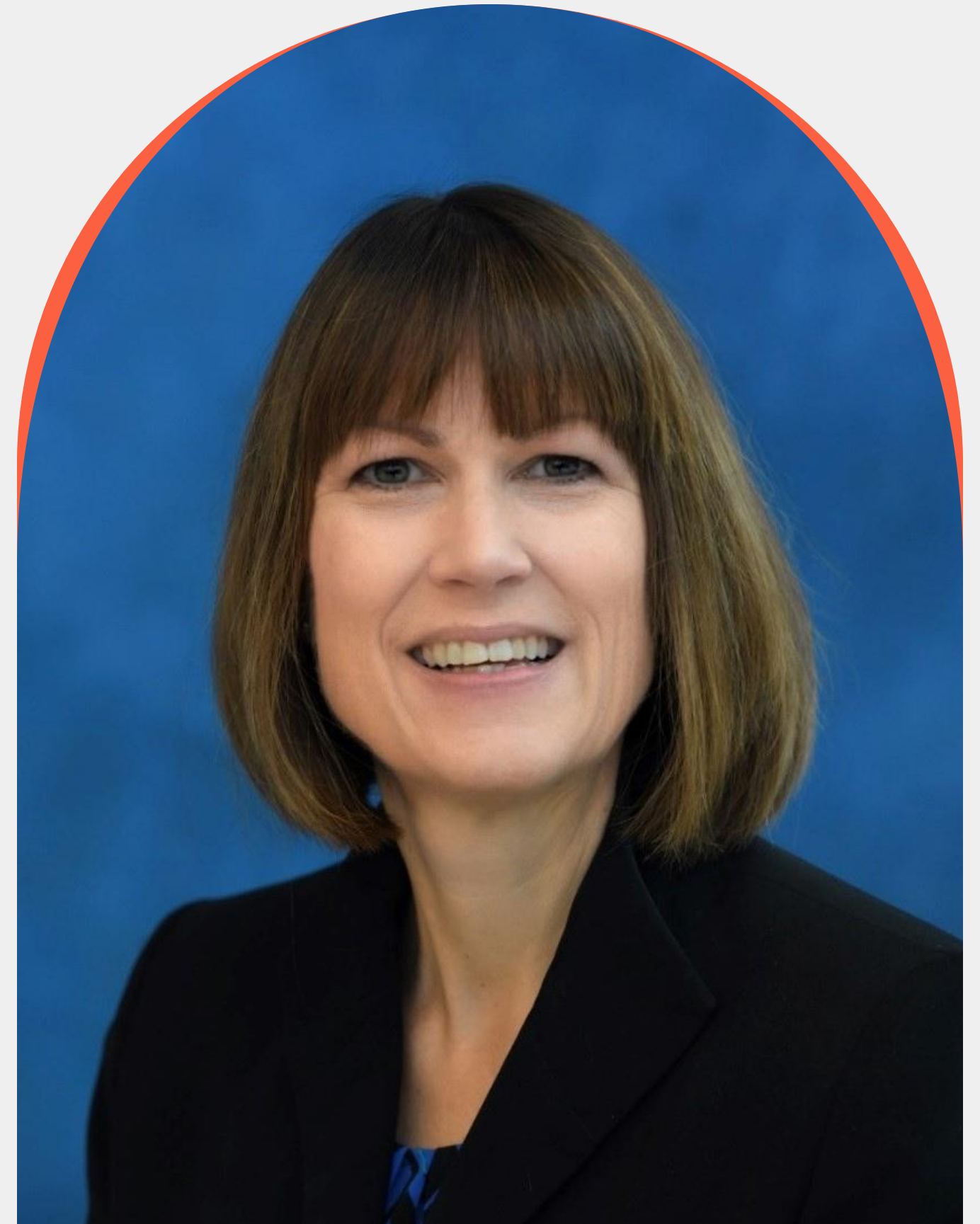

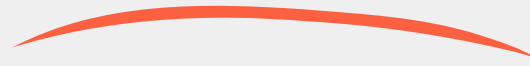
Meet the Moderator
